+ BIRTHDAY (5E JARIANT RULE)+

- Sometimes, a player feels like they should get just one day off from adventuring.
 - But when?
 - Of course! Let's celebrate a birthday
- Can only celebrate if:
 - They are not currently on a quest
 - The player/character has at least 3 members to celebrate with
 - The party must be set within a week of the character's birthday

YOU KNOW YOU'RE OLD




WHEN YOU NEED MORE THAN ONE D20 TO ROLL YOUR AGE





+ BIRTHDAY (5E JARIANT RULE)+

- If conditions are met, the player can have an official birthday party:
 - Every character gives the Birthday Player's character a gift of gold or equipment
 - Birthday Player's character receives +1 to
 Charisma during the next quest
 - Birthday Player brings cake
 - other players sing the birthday song





THE NEW ROLE OF CYBER ACTION OFFICER

- Maintain situational awareness of cyber activity by reviewing DoD, Intelligence Community and open source reporting for new vulnerabilities, malware or other threats that have the potential to impact the DoDIN.
- Serve as a lead for planning, coordination, implementation, validation, mitigation, and compliance of cyber security tasks.
- Prepare and present senior level briefings to share information and status.
- Resolve problems with functionality or performance.
- Prepare orders for staffing and release and serve as main POC for inquiries and communications after order release.
- Support mission-critical Continuity of Operations (COOP).

 - Tabletop Exercises (TTXs) (90%)



- 1 Dungeon Master (DM)

tl;dr: Invent a character, explore a fantasy world, talk to the people living there, fight crazy monsters, acquire plunder and glory, roll dice, drink beers and yell at your friends!








 - x1 four-sided, eight-sided, twelve-sided
 - x2 ten-sided
 - x4 six-sided



Dungeon Master

- Narrate the story
- Control NPCs and Monsters
- Ensure players are engaged and having fun
- Answer player questions
- Adjust the speed of the game
- Adjust play as necessary

tl;dr: The DM is god.









<u>Gameplay</u>

- Exploration
 - primary story developer
 - involves:
 - solving puzzles
 - surmounting obstacles
 - Iooking for treasure

tl;dr: look for clues, traps, treasure, and secrets.

<u>Gameplay</u>

- Combat
 - Attack
 - D20+STR or DEX+Proficiency
 - Hit? Roll again to determine hit pts
 - Defend Same as above
 - HP below 0 = Death!

tl;dr: Roll a D20 to see if you hit or not, then roll another die to see how much damage you did.



TRIPPED AND FELL LEAVING THE TAVERN TO GO ON ADVENTURE **DIES FROM FALLING DAMAGE 1ST LEVEL PROBLEMS**

<u>Gameplay</u>

- Interaction
 - non-player characters (NPCs)
 - charisma/influence
 - threats of violence
 - disguise
 - bribery/interrogation

tl;dr: use disguises or influence to acquire information.

<u>Gameplay</u>

- Level-up
 - gain experience pts (XP)
 - win combat
 - solve puzzle
 - successful with an NPC
 - XP is cumulative; level-up at 300, 900, 2700, 6500, 14000, 23000, etc.

tl;dr: XP is the reason for playing.

+15 XP +15 XP

DM: You enter the orphanage. A group of hungry children look at you with a spark of hope in their eyes.

PC: A chaotic-evil murder-orc needing XP :)

 - Use relevant documentation
 - Schedule planning meetings (IPM, MPM, FPM)
 - Set high-level goals








Session-Zero

 - Cite past incidents
 - your own company
 - industry
 - Research cyber threats
 - Leverage your network

 - Technical/CTF?
 - Business process testing
 - Cross-functional collaboration







<u>Home-brew the story</u>

- "Write out your adventure"
 - Scenario Overview
 - Master Scenario Events List (MSEL)
 - Slides







Home-brew the story

- "Be flexible with your plot"
 - Participants may throw off your plans
 - Be prepared to improvise





STORYT

Damn the consequences, damn the love interest, damn the xp, we're getting the girl. GMing done right.





<u>Home-brew the story</u>

- "Practice run your adventure"
 - Co-worker
 - Brief the sponsor/team
 - Brief BU Exec







<u>Running the Game</u>

- "A good DM controls the pace of play and referees the action"
 - Cover the rules
 - Discuss the goals/outcomes
 - EXERCISE EXERCISE EXERCISE
 - Adjust for time
 - Take Notes / Record meeting







After the Game

- "Campaign Aftercare is a DM's best tool for improvement"
 - $\circ\,$ End of TTX feedback slide
 - After-Action Review (AAR) Report and Meeting
 - Leveling-Up
 - Process Improvement
 Opportunities
